The Gongoliers' Structure

- Four team departments
 Each department has...
 - Student Director
 - Lead Positions
 - General Department Members

Team Presidents alongside Student Directors make up the Board of Directors (BoD)



Why Have a Team Structure?

- Organization
- Sustainability
- Empowerment







Organization

- Each position on the team has a set role
- Tasks can be assigned to people who are more experienced in their specific area
- General members can work with Lead Positions to learn as well



Sustainability

- Higher level positions have trained replacements
 - When a team member graduates, the structure allows for returning members to fill in their place
 - Ex. When a Director graduates on our team, there are several student Leads below them



Empowerment

- Students get to learn about their preferred interest and it encourages them to be leaders to their peers
 Ex. Brand Manager

The Gongoliers' Structure Explained

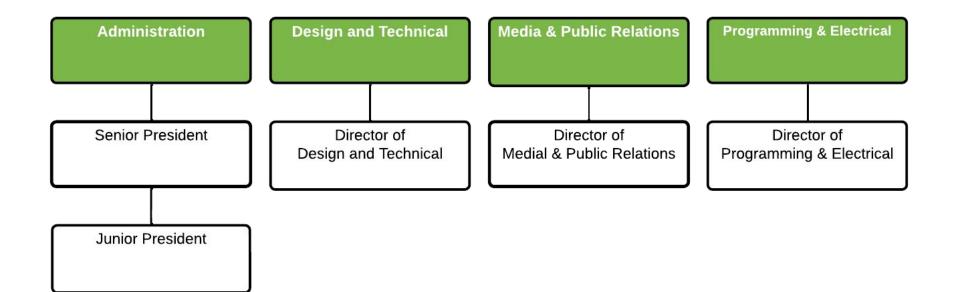


Board of Directors (BoD)

- Each Department has a student Director
- Each Director and the Junior and Senior President sit on the BoD
- The BoD makes all major decisions for the team
 - Exceptions are financial decisions or school policy matters



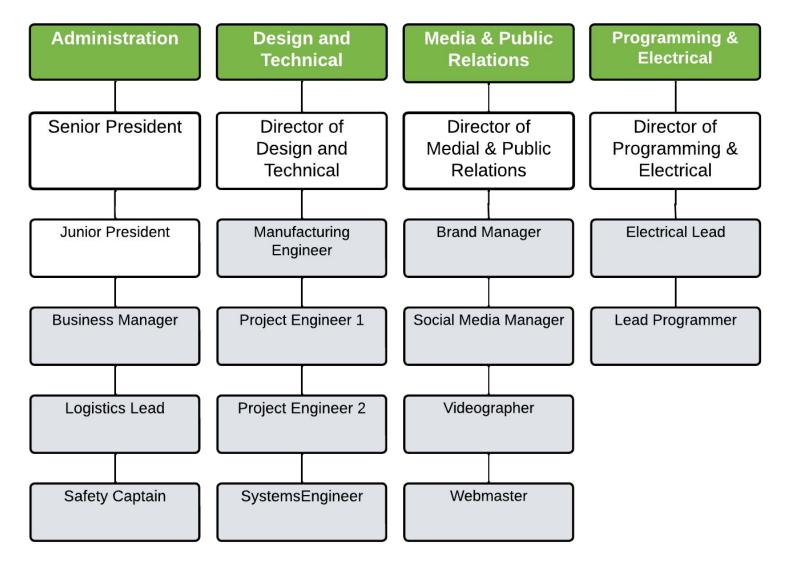
BoD Departments





- Each department has different Lead Positions
- Lead Positions have a specific area of a department that they help guide
- General department members work with their Director/Leads and peers

Application Procedure

- Each team member has the opportunity to apply for Lead positions, Director positions, and Junior President
- Team members can apply for multiple positions
 - Ex. Director and Lead in the same department



Position Descriptions Example

- Senior President
- The Senior President is responsible for posting meeting agendas and contacting parents and sponsors. The Senior President is the chair of the Impact Committee and is responsible for being the team liaison with parents and school district faculty and staff.



Application Procedure

- Applications require more information for each level
 - All position require an interview with team mentors
 - Junior President and directors require an essay
 - Junior President requires teacher recommendation



Interview Procedure

- An interview schedule based on mentor availability is posted so that team members can choose a time
- The panel will be three Lead Mentors
 - Department Lead Mentor
 - 2 Additional Mentors



Interview Procedure

- Mentors meet to make all decisions after all of the interviews conclude
- Feedback is provided to all of the team members that have interviewed
 - What worked well in the interview
 - What can be improved in the future
